



Natural Born Champions Program Policies

Who We Are

Natural Born Champions Inc. (NBC), is a community intervention program that aims to provide direct educational and extracurricular services for the inner-city youth and educators in Baltimore City, Maryland. NBC's mission is to condition and empower youthful minds to realize their full academic potential. NBC staff consists of a team of Baltimore residents, who are leaders in their community with a commitment to serving youth. The Baltimore City Public School (BCPS) system is often regarded as inferior to their suburban counterparts; consequently, academically inferior students become a by-product in poor performing schools and unsupportive communities which then undermines the student's purpose in today's society. NBC is uniquely designed to fill in the gap and help our students achieve.

Natural Born Champions Programs

NBC offers several youth service programs. Currently we host a Virtual Assistance Program (VAP), Before & After Care/Extended Care Program, and Camp Champions. Each program hosts 10-12 students ages 3-13. Camp Champions host up to 25 campers. Students are able to experience 1-to-1 tutoring, a plethora of hands-on activities, nutritional meals, and field trips. Extended Care Program and Little Champion Care operates yearly from September-June. Camp Champions operates every summer from June-August. Specific dates vary depending on the school calendar. These are non-contractual programs. However, NBC requires registration for each program.

Terms & Fees

NBC programs require a registration/membership fee of \$50. This membership fee is valid for 1 year. Each year participants must renew their membership with Natural Born Champions. With the NBC membership, participants may utilize all of NBC's services including all programs and transportation services. Program and transportation services fees vary.

Transportation is a flat rate of \$25/week, which includes either pick-up or drop-off by NBC, within a 5 mile radius of NBC's site. There is an additional \$5 for every 3 miles outside of the allotted travel distance and it is not to exceed 20 miles. If you utilize transportation services, your child can only have 1 designated drop-off or pick-up location. However, we will allow one additional emergency drop-off location. Please confirm transportation location(s) with Director. All see Transportation Policy for further details and rates.



No participant will be permitted into any NBC program without payment or proper communication to Director, prior to drop-off. There will be an additional \$20 per day charge the participant is on the premises. An invoice of unpaid balances will be sent via email. If your balance exceeds \$200, your membership will be voided and you will not be allowed to reregister to any NBC program. Participants who attend VAP or before/after care programs should have breakfast prior to drop-off or come with breakfast and 2 snacks! Participants who do not utilize transportation services will be subject to late pick-up/drop-off fees. There will be an additional \$5 for every 5 minutes participants are left on NBC premises after closing. An invoice will be sent via email and must be satisfied before the participant can reenter any NBC program. NBC only provides lunch to all students. During summer, Camp Champions provides both breakfast and lunch, parents are responsible to provide 2 snacks to campers.

COVID-19 Precautions

All participants must wear masks for the 2020-2021 calendar year until further notice. All participants are required to pass COVID-19 pre-screening before participating in any NBC program or service. Pre-screening is submitted on NBC registration. Temperatures will be taken for each participant prior to entrance of NBC facility. If participants are feeling ill or have experienced any COVID symptoms, they will be asked to stay home or will be returned home.



Natural Born Champions Transportation Policy

Policy

Transportation is a flat rate of \$25/week, which includes either pick-up or drop-off by NBC, within a 5 mile radius of NBC's site. There is an additional \$5 for every 3 miles outside of the allotted travel distance and it is not to exceed 20 miles. If you utilize transportation services, your child can only have 1 designated drop-off or pick-up location. However, we will allow one additional emergency drop-off location. NBC services any zip code within 5-20 miles of 21202. NBC provides door-to-door services for those within 5 miles of 21202. NBC also services 21117, 21244, 21207, 21237, 21220. Pickup & drop-off locations that exceeds 5-9 miles of NBC site has service zones where parents are responsible to pickup and/or drop-off students at specific times. Zones are as followed: Milford Mill Academy (21244), Owings Mills Elementary (21117), Forest Park Senior High School (21207), Golden Ring Middle School (21237), and Middle River Middle School (21220).

Additional Notes

Transportation is an additional service. Transportation fees are not included with participation in NBC programs. NBC program fees vary. Participants who utilize transportation services are required to confirm pick-up and drop-off locations and times with NBC Director. Masks must be worn by all travelers.
